- Local Tribal members
- Youth between the ages of 16-24
- · Organizational leaders from health, social, economic, or environmental fields that focus on equity
- Academics or researchers with expertise in addressing the underlying causes of health, social, economic, or environmental disparities in unjustly impacted communities
- Other self-identified characteristics will be considered to strengthen representation particularly
 for groups often marginalized or under-represented in public participation processes (i.e., people
 who identify as BIPOC, LGBTQ+, youth, immigrants and refugees, unhoused, low-income, or live in
 an unincorporated or rural area)
